After my last clinical correlations class I feel proficient at eliciting information that is needed to make a differential diagnosis. My weakness remains understanding which treatment to start with for the differentials diagnoses for certain populations. For example, I struggled with knowing how to treat first time non-symptomatic A.Fib (beta blockers) versus a symptomatic A. fib patient (cardioversion). I look forward to clinicals sharpening my skills about what to order and how to treat conditions based on the patient's clinical disposition/age/labs based on evidenced based medicine.
